From all of us here at Ceres, we hope you, your staff and your families are staying safe during this unprecedented coronavirus pandemic.

Over the past month, Ceres has taken a critical look at how we prepare, respond and perform debris removal services if a disaster strikes. This has challenged us to think more critically about each individual element of our work and how we protect our personnel, government staff and the general public. With this in mind, Ceres has:

- · Developed and distributed coronavirus Go Kits to deploying personnel
- Revised corporate travel policies for lodging and rental car use to safeguard personnel from coronavirus
- Instituted daily cleaning/disinfecting procedures for all project equipment (currently used for day-to-day operations at mulching yards and ongoing construction projects)
- Revamped management and operational plans to limit to person-to-person contact and update hazardous waste operations to include coronavirus disposables
- Revised Corporate Health and Safety Plan used on debris removal project to provide training for additional PPE requirements, respiratory protection, bloodborne pathogens, and hazard communication

Moving forward, attached is our updated 2020 Point of Contact list should you need to activate the Ceres contract or you simply need debris removal or FEMA guidance.

By now, Ceres would have begun outreach for pre-season debris coordination meetings. While that has not started, Ceres is looking at alternative ways to engage clients to prepare for the this upcoming hurricane season. Ceres is happy to facilitate debris coordination meetings over Zoom, Skype or GoToMeeting. We are also happy to push our pre-season in-person debris coordination meetings to late June, throughout July and August. Regardless of whether we meet virtually or in-person, Ceres is willing to distribute important FEMA updates by physical mail. Agreement for Storm Debris Removal-Amendment 1

Whereas, The City of Palm Bay, Florida competitively selected and entered into a contract on August 3,2017 through May 31, 2020 with Ceres Environmental Services, Inc. Professional Parkway East, Sarasota, Florida 34240 to provide Debris Removal/Disaster Recovery Services, and

Whereas, the City of Palm Bay renewed its contract with Ceres Environmental Services, Inc. from June 1, 2020 through May 31, 2021.

Whereas, The Port Malabar Holiday Park Recreation District, a special unit of local government created pursuant to Chapter 418.2 Florida Statutes is geographically located within the corporate limits of Palm Bay Florida, with substantially the same community of interest as the City, and

Whereas, The District may obtain certain contractual services as provided for by Chapter 189.4221 Florida Statutes including Debris Removal/Disaster Recovery Services utilizing the terms and conditions of the City of Palm Bay, Florida's competitively awarded contract with Ceres Environmental Services, Inc. if/when it is in the best interest of the District.

Now therefore:

- 1. Ceres Environmental Services, Inc. affirms and ratifies the terms and conditions of the aforementioned contract and amendments, copies of which are attached hereto and made a part of hereof and offers to provide the same Debris Removal/Disaster Recovery to the Port Malabar Holiday Park Mobile Park Recreation District.
- 2. The Port Malabar Holiday Park Mobile Park Recreation District agrees to purchase Debris Removal/ Disaster Recovery services on a non-exclusive basis from Ceres Environmental Services, Inc. under the same contract provisions and level of service provided to the City of Palm Bay, FL if/when it is in the District's best interest.
